
YMM Quick Connections to Nanaimo

On the YMM Runway: RCMP Dream Experience

Ten-year-old Tessa Booth and her mother, Dawn, the communications coordinator for the Fort McMurray Airport Authority, arrived at YMM on July 22 in a Cessna Citation Mustang High

Sierra Edition. The flight, piloted by Don Riep, a board member of the Kids with Cancer Society (KWCS), and Perry McPherson, who generously volunteered their time and aircraft, marked the final leg of their journey home from the RCMP Training Academy in Regina, Sask.

This adventure was part of an incredible 'RCMP Dream Experience' where Tessa and her new friend Janine Wich from Lloydminster served as Co-Commanding Officers of the Alberta RCMP for 48 hours. It was a unique opportunity made possible for the two childhood cancer survivors through a partnership between KWCS and the Alberta RCMP.

The excitement kicked off with a Change of Command ceremony at the Alberta RCMP Headquarters in Edmonton, led by Deputy Commissioner Trevor Daroux. After a tour of HQ, the girls took to the skies, co-piloting an Airbus Helicopter H125 at the RCMP hangar at YEG. They then boarded the Alberta RCMP's Pilatus PC-12 to reach the Depot, embracing their roles as Commanding Officers with an overnight stay at the academy. Their return flight to YEG was on the Saskatchewan RCMP's Pilatus PC-12 surveillance aircraft.

Among many memorable moments, a highlight was when Dawn reconnected with former Team YMM member Ryder Ouellette, who used to work at YMM Earls Kitchen + Bar and is now training as a cadet.




August YMM Passenger of the Month


Team YMM Spotlight on Joel Perez






Community In Focus: Supertest Speedway


These fire-resistant plants not only boost our curbside appeal, but also play a crucial role in reducing wildfire risks. These plants were sourced from local garden centers.

Pet Relief Area at YMM

Located inside and outside of the terminal, YMM's pet relief areas accommodates service animals and travelling pets.

At Arrivals on Level 1, three pet relief areas are on-location, two inside separate single-person washrooms; one located on the right side of the terminal entry, one by Carousel 2 and one outside in the YMM Courtyard (courtyard entry/exit located between baggage carousels).

After Security, pet relief areas are available at Gate 1, 2 and 4 washrooms. Look for signage throughout the terminal. Sanitation supplies are available. Do not flush supplies down the toilet, be sure to discard them in provided garbage bins.
